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Prayer Chaplain Program

Prayer Chaplain Program is one of the most powerful and personal ways Unity of the Triangle serves the spiritual needs of its congregants through one-on-one confidential prayer.

Serving as a volunteer Prayer Chaplain involves a deep level of **commitment**, an openness to create heart connections with others, and a willingness to experience personal and spiritual growth and transformation.

Completing the Prayer Chaplain training and “being” a Prayer Chaplain is transformational soul work.

We invite you to prayerfully consider whether becoming a Prayer Chaplain is yours to do.

What is a Prayer Chaplain?

Prayer Chaplains are trained volunteers who provide congregants confidential, one-on-one, affirmative prayer. They have a deeply committed private prayer practice and a willingness to practice Unity principles.

Their role is to:

- ♥ Create and hold sacred spiritual space with you during prayer
- ♥ Lovingly and empathetically listen to your prayer request

- ♥ Pray from the heart allowing Spirit to speak through them
- ♥ Honor the sacred trust that is created when praying with another
- ♥ Hold all that is shared in the strictest confidence

Prayer Chaplains are not ordained nor do they “minister” or counsel the community at large as do ministers or hospital chaplains.

Commitment

Joining the Prayer Chaplain Program is a service opportunity for those who are truly looking to take the next step in the development of their spiritual maturity.

Prayer Chaplains make a **one-year commitment** to fulfill their service responsibilities, and they serve approximately **8 hours per month** by:

- Offering prayer support at least two Sunday services per month (2 hours)
- Making Wellness Prayer Calls once a month to members (2-3 hours)
- Attending monthly Prayer Chaplain deepening meetings (2 hours)
- Mentoring and supporting other Prayer Chaplains (1 hour)

Requirements

- You must be an active member of Unity of the Triangle for one year to enter the Prayer Chaplain Program.
- The Affirmative Prayer/Life of Prayer class is a required prerequisite.
- No prior prayer experience or training is necessary; we do meet with you prior to training to jointly discuss your commitment level and readiness for training.
- We offer thorough training to prepare you for the next step into service consisting of informational meetings, interviews, two Sunday on-site training sessions, a weekend retreat and dedication ceremonies.
